



Why you should join:

The International Society on General Relativity and Gravitation (ISGRG) is the descendant of the earlier Committee on General Relativity and Gravitation and was founded in 1971. As an Affiliated Commission of the International Union of Pure and Applied Physics (IUPAP), it provides the way for gravity researchers to take part in international science policy-making, and to seek IUPAP's sponsorship for meetings in our field.

- **The triennial GRn conferences** are organized by the Society. Members receive a discounted registration fee for these conferences.
- **The Society's journal** was originally published by Plenum Press, and after changes of ownership of the publisher is now published by Springer. Members receive discounted rates on individual electronic only or print subscriptions to the journal.
- **Discounts on book purchases** are offered by Cambridge University Press, Springer, and World Scientific.
- **The public 'Hyperspace@aei' website** is sponsored by the Society displays and distributes information for those in the field.
- **Policy issues.** The Society acts as the voice of the GRG community in international science policy, through its role with IUPAP as an Affiliated Commission.
- **Prizes.** The Society awards the **annual** IUPAP General Relativity and Gravitation Young Scientist Prize, offered for the first time in 2013, and two triennial prizes, the Jürgen Ehlers thesis prize for classical general relativity and the Bergmann-Wheeler thesis prize for quantum gravity, first offered in 2010. In addition, it makes a number of Hartle Awards for student presentations and Chandrasekhar Awards for postdoc presentations at each GRn conference.
- **Fellowships.** The International Society for General Relativity and Gravitation has instituted Fellowships to recognize its outstanding members.
